



MAKE GRAIN HYGIENE YOUR PRIORITY ON-FARM

**You are the first checkpoint for grain
entering the export supply chain**

- ✓ Plant viable and clean seed. Use a seed dressing if required
- ✓ Apply chemicals according to label requirements
- ✓ Adhere to withholding periods
- ✓ Clean your equipment and machinery prior to storing and delivering grain. This includes:
 - Harvesters
 - Trucks and trailers
 - Augers
 - Chaser bins
 - Field bins
 - Silos
- ✓ If required, use a seed grader to ensure your crop meets quality standards
- ✓ Ensure stored grain is treated appropriately for future planting or sale
